- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 51, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 51.609 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 51.609. UNCOLLECTIBLE FEES. (a) The clerk may
- 8 request the court in which a court cost or fee was imposed on a party
- 9 in a civil case to make a finding that the cost or fee is
- 10 uncollectible if the cost or fee has been unpaid for at least 15
- 11 years.
- 12 (b) On a finding by a court that a court cost or fee imposed
- on a party in a civil case is uncollectible, the court may order the
- 14 clerk to designate the cost or fee as uncollectible in the fee
- 15 record. The clerk shall attach a copy of the court's order to the
- 16 fee record.
- 17 <u>(c) This section does not apply to a court cost or fee</u>
- 18 imposed by the supreme court, the court of criminal appeals, or a
- 19 <u>court of appeals.</u>
- 20 SECTION 2. Article 103.0081(c), Code of Criminal Procedure,
- 21 is repealed.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
