A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the conversion or dissolution of certain conservation
- 3 and reclamation districts.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 49.321, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 49.321. DISSOLUTION AUTHORITY. After notice [and
- 8 hearing], the commission or executive director may dissolve any
- 9 district that is inactive for a period of five consecutive years and
- 10 has no outstanding bonded indebtedness.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 49.324, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 12 follows:
- Sec. 49.324. ORDER OF DISSOLUTION. The commission or the
- 14 executive director may enter an order dissolving the district [at
- 15 the conclusion of the hearing] if the commission or executive
- 16 <u>director</u> [it] finds that the district has performed none of the
- 17 functions for which it was created for a period of five consecutive
- 18 years [before the day of the proceeding] and that the district has
- 19 no outstanding bonded indebtedness.
- SECTION 3. Section 49.326(a), Water Code, is amended to
- 21 read as follows:
- 22 (a) Appeals from <u>an</u> [a commission] order dissolving a
- 23 district shall be filed and heard in the district court of any of
- 24 the counties in which the land is located.

- 1 SECTION 4. Section 54.030(b), Water Code, is amended to
- 2 read as follows:
- 3 (b) The governing body of a district which desires to
- 4 convert into a district operating under this chapter shall adopt
- 5 and enter in the minutes of the governing body a resolution
- 6 declaring that in its judgment, conversion into a municipal utility
- 7 district operating under this chapter and under Article XVI,
- 8 Section 59, of the Texas Constitution, would serve the best
- 9 interest of the district and would be a benefit to the land and
- 10 property included in the district. The resolution shall also
- 11 request that the commission approve [to hold a hearing on the
- 12 question of the district.
- SECTION 5. Section 54.032, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 14 follows:
- Sec. 54.032. CONVERSION OF DISTRICT: NOTICE. (a) Notice
- 16 of the conversion [hearing] shall be given by publishing notice in a
- 17 newspaper with general circulation in the county or counties in
- 18 which the district is located.
- 19 (b) The notice shall be published once a week for two
- 20 consecutive weeks [with the first publication to be made not less
- 21 than 14 full days before the time set for the hearing].
- 22 (c) The notice shall:
- 23 (1) [state the time and place of the hearing;
- $[\frac{(2)}{2}]$ set out the resolution adopted by the district
- 25 in full; and
- (2) $[\frac{(3)}{(3)}]$ notify all interested persons how they may
- 27 offer comments [to appear and offer testimony] for or against the

- 1 proposal contained in the resolution.
- 2 SECTION 6. Section 54.033, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 Sec. 54.033. CONVERSION OF DISTRICT; FINDINGS. (a) If
- 5 [After a hearing, if] the commission or the executive director
- 6 finds that conversion of the district into one operating under this
- 7 chapter would serve the best interest of the district and would be a
- 8 benefit to the land and property included in the district, the
- 9 commission or executive director [it] shall enter an order making
- 10 this finding and the district shall become a district operating
- 11 under this chapter and no confirmation election shall be required.
- 12 (b) If the commission or the executive director finds that
- 13 the conversion of the district would not serve the best interest of
- 14 the district and would not be a benefit to the land and property
- 15 included in the district, the commission or executive director [it]
- 16 shall enter an order against conversion of the district into one
- 17 operating under this chapter.
- 18 (c) The findings of the commission or the executive director
- 19 entered under this section shall be subject to appeal or review
- 20 within 30 days after entry of the order [of the commission] granting
- 21 or denying the conversion.
- 22 (d) A copy of the [commission] order converting a district
- 23 shall be filed in the deed records of the county or counties in
- 24 which the district is located.
- 25 SECTION 7. Sections 49.322 and 54.031, Water Code, are
- 26 repealed.
- 27 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
