A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

L AN ACT

- 2 relating to designating May 8 as Military Spouse Appreciation Day.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 662.071 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 662.071. MILITARY SPOUSE APPRECIATION DAY. (a) May 8
- 7 is Military Spouse Appreciation Day to recognize the role of the
- 8 wives and husbands of the brave individuals who serve in the United
- 9 States armed forces or state military forces. This day
- 10 commemorates:
- 11 (1) the sacrifices military spouses make during the
- 12 weeks, months, and years a loved one is away from home protecting
- 13 our freedom; and
- 14 (2) the vital support military spouses provide to
- 15 veterans returning home from military service.
- 16 (b) Military Spouse Appreciation Day shall be regularly
- 17 observed by appropriate programs and activities coordinated by the
- 18 Texas Veterans Commission.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
