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5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 41A.03(a-1), Tax Code, is amended to

7 read as follows:

8 (a-1) If a property owner requests binding arbitration

9 under this chapter to appeal appraisal review board orders

10 involving two or more <u>contiguous</u> tracts of land that are <u>owned by</u>

11 the property owner [contiguous to one another], a single

12 arbitration deposit in the amount provided by Subsection (a)(2) is

13 sufficient to satisfy the requirement of Subsection (a)(2). For

14 purposes of this subsection, "contiguous tracts of land" means

15 improved or unimproved tracts of land that are touching or that

16 share a common boundary, as determined using appraisal district

17 records or legal descriptions of the tracts.

18 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to

a request for binding arbitration under Chapter 41A, Tax Code, that

20 is filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A request for

21 binding arbitration under Chapter 41A, Tax Code, that is filed

22 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in

23 effect on the date the request is filed, and the former law is

24 continued in effect for that purpose.

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1	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
2	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
3	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
4	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
5	Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
