3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 51.9715, Education Code, is amended by
5	adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
6	(c) An institution of higher education or a school district
7	offering international baccalaureate courses, dual credit courses,
8	or any other course for which the institution a student attends has
9	awarded the student college course credit, including course credit
10	awarded by examination, may release student information for the
11	purposes of the transfer of course credit between institutions of
12	higher education. Student information released under this
13	subsection serves the legitimate educational interest of the
14	student for whom consent would otherwise be required under the
15	Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (20 U.S.C.
16	Section 1232g).
17	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
18	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
19	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
20	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
21	Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
