- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 41.001(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except as otherwise provided by this subchapter, each
- 8 general or special election in this state shall be held on one of
- 9 the following dates:
- 10 (1) the first Saturday in May in an odd-numbered year,
- 11 for an election other than an election held by a city with a
- 12 population of 1.18 million or more, located predominantly in a
- 13 county that has a total area of less than 1,000 square miles, that
- 14 has adopted a council-manager form of government;
- 15 (2) the first Saturday in May in an even-numbered
- 16 year, for an election held by a political subdivision other than a
- 17 city with a population of 1.18 million or more, located
- 18 predominantly in a county that has a total area of less than 1,000
- 19 square miles, that has adopted a council-manager form of
- 20 government, or a county; or
- 21 (3) the first Tuesday after the first Monday in
- 22 November.
- SECTION 2. Section 41.0052, Election Code, is amended by
- 24 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:

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- (f) The governing body of a city with a population of 1.18 1 million or more, located predominantly in a county that has a total 2 area of less than 1,000 square miles, that has adopted a 3 4 council-manager form of government and that holds its general election for officers on a date other than the November uniform 5 6 election date shall, not later than December 31, 2020, change the 7 date on which it holds its general election for officers to the November uniform election date. This subsection expires January 1, 8 9 2021.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
