To the extent that federal funds become available under 8 9 federal law[, regulation, or executive action after March 1, 2017], 10 the commissioner may: (1) apply for such funds; and 11 12 (2) use such funds to establish and administer a temporary health insurance risk pool for the purposes of this 13 14 chapter. SECTION 2. Section 1510.008(a), Insurance Code, is amended 15 to read as follows: 16 (a) The commissioner may apply to the United States 17 secretary of health and human services: 18 (1) under 42 U.S.C. Section 18052 for a waiver of 19 applicable provisions of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care 20 21 Act (Pub. L. No. 111-148) and any applicable regulations or 22 guidance; or (2) under any applicable provision of federal law 23 [enacted on or after May 1, 2017,] for a waiver of applicable 24

1 provisions of any federal law, regulations, or guidance with respect to health insurance coverage consistent with Section 2 1510.003.

4 SECTION 3. Section 1510.012(a), Insurance Code, is amended 5 to read as follows:

6 (a) Beginning June 1, 2020 [2018], not later than June 1 of 7 each year, the department shall submit a report to the governor, the 8 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of 9 representatives.

SECTION 4. Section 1510.013, Insurance Code, is amended to 10 read as follows: 11

Sec. 1510.013. EXPIRATION OF CHAPTER. 12 This chapter expires August 31, 2021 [2019]. 13

SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 14 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 16 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2019. 18
