- 7 <u>(c) The board shall make the information reported under</u>
- 8 Subsection (a) available to the State Board of Veterinary Medical
- 9 Examiners for the purpose of routine inspections and
- 10 investigations.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 801.307, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 12 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 13 <u>(a-1)</u> The board shall require a veterinarian to complete two
- 14 hours of continuing education related to opioid abuse and
- 15 controlled substance diversion, inventory, and security every two
- 16 years to renew a license to practice veterinary medicine.
- 17 SECTION 3. Section 801.307(a-1), Occupations Code, as added
- 18 by this Act, applies only to the renewal of a license to practice
- 19 veterinary medicine on or after September 1, 2020. The renewal of a
- 20 license before that date is governed by the law in effect
- 21 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former
- 22 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
