5	SECTION 1. Section 55.007(a), Transportation Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) The committee shall:
8	(1) prepare <u>the</u> [a] maritime port mission plan
9	described by Section 55.008;
10	(2) review each project eligible to be funded under
11	this chapter and make recommendations for approval or disapproval
12	to the department; and
13	(3) [every two years prepare a report on Texas
14	maritime ports, with a list of projects that have been recommended
15	by the committee, including:
16	[(A) the recommended funding level for each
17	project; and
18	[(B) if staged implementation of the project is
19	appropriate, the funding requirements for each stage; and
20	[(4)] advise the commission and the department on
21	matters relating to port authorities.
22	SECTION 2. Section 55.008, Transportation Code, is amended
23	to read as follows:
24	Sec. 55.008. <u>MARITIME PORT MISSION PLAN</u> [CAPITAL PROGRAM].

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(a) The committee shall prepare a two-year <u>maritime</u> port <u>mission</u>
<u>plan</u> [capital program] defining the goals and objectives of the
committee concerning the development of maritime port facilities
and an intermodal transportation system. The <u>plan</u> [port capital
program] must include projects or studies submitted to the
committee by any maritime port and recommendations for:

7 (1) the construction of transportation facilities8 connecting any maritime port to another transportation mode; and

9 (2) the efficient, cost-effective development of 10 transportation facilities or maritime port facilities for the 11 purpose of:

(A) enhancing international trade; 12 13 (B) enhancing security; 14 (C) promoting cargo flow; 15 (D) increasing cruise passenger movements; 16 (E) increasing maritime port revenues; and 17 providing economic benefits to the state. (F) (b) The committee shall update the maritime port mission 18 plan [capital program] and shall submit the updated plan [capital 19 program] not later than December 1 of each even-numbered year to: 20 (1) the governor; 21 22 (2) the lieutenant governor; the speaker of the house of representatives; and 23 (3) 24 (4) the commission. 25 SECTION 3. Section 55.007(b), Transportation Code, is repealed. 26 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 27

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1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
