4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 55.007(a), Transportation Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) The committee shall:
8	(1) prepare $\underline{\text{the}}$ [$\underline{\textbf{a}}$] maritime port mission plan

- described by Section 55.008; 9
- 10 review each project eligible to be funded under this chapter and make recommendations for approval or disapproval 11 12 to the department; and
- (3) [every two years prepare a report 13 maritime ports, with a list of projects that have been recommended 14 by the committee, including: 15
- 16 [(A) the recommended funding level for each 17 project; and
- [(B) if staged implementation of the project is 18 appropriate, the funding requirements for each stage; and 19
- 20 $[\frac{(4)}{(4)}]$ advise the commission and the department on 21 matters relating to port authorities.
- 22 SECTION 2. Section 55.008, Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 23
- Sec. 55.008. MARITIME PORT MISSION PLAN [CAPITAL PROGRAM]. 24

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1 (a) The committee shall prepare a two-year <u>maritime</u> port <u>mission</u>
2 <u>plan</u> [<del>capital program</del>] defining the goals and objectives of the
3 committee concerning the development of maritime port facilities
4 and an intermodal transportation system. The <u>plan</u> [<del>port capital</del>
5 <u>program</u>] must include projects or studies submitted to the
6 committee by any maritime port and recommendations for:
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- 7 (1) the construction of transportation facilities 8 connecting any maritime port to another transportation mode; and
- 9 (2) the efficient, cost-effective development of 10 transportation facilities or maritime port facilities for the 11 purpose of:
- 12 (A) enhancing international trade;
- 13 (B) enhancing security;
- 14 (C) promoting cargo flow;
- 15 (D) increasing cruise passenger movements;
- 16 (E) increasing maritime port revenues; and
- 17 (F) providing economic benefits to the state.
- (b) The committee shall update the <u>maritime</u> port <u>mission</u>

 19 <u>plan</u> [capital program] and shall submit the <u>updated plan</u> [capital

 20 <u>program</u>] not later than December 1 of each even-numbered year to:
- 21 (1) the governor;
- 22 (2) the lieutenant governor;
- 23 (3) the speaker of the house of representatives; and
- 24 (4) the commission.
- 25 SECTION 3. Section 55.007(b), Transportation Code, is 26 repealed.
- 27 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
