9	of a hospital district created under general or special law may
10	conduct a closed meeting to deliberate business and financial
11	issues relating to a contract being negotiated if, before
12	conducting the closed meeting:
13	(1) the governing board votes unanimously that
14	deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on
15	the position of the governing board in negotiations with a third
16	person; and
17	(2) the attorney advising the governing board issues a
18	written determination that deliberation in an open meeting would
19	have a detrimental effect on the position of the governing board in
20	negotiations with a third person.
21	(b) Notwithstanding Section 551.103(a), the governing board
22	of a hospital district must make a recording of the proceedings of a
23	closed meeting to deliberate the information.
24	SECTION 2. Section 551.085, Government Code, is amended by

1 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

(c) This chapter does not require the governing board of a
hospital district created under general or special law to conduct
an open meeting to deliberate information relating to a proposed
expansion of an existing service or product line of the hospital
district before publicly announcing the expansion.
SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
