1 AN ACT relating to the fee collected for a municipal solid waste permit 2 application; increasing a fee. 3 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 5.701, Water Code, is amended by adding 5 6 Subsection (r) to read as follows: 7 (r) The executive director shall charge a fee for filing a municipal solid waste permit application under Chapter 361, Health 8 and Safety Code, in the amount of \$5,000 plus the cost of required 9 10 notice. Money collected under this subsection may only be used to inspect the facility or site used or proposed to be used to store, 11 process, or dispose of municipal solid waste to confirm information 12 included in the permit application. The inspection shall be 13 conducted prior to the issuance of a permit. The commission by rule 14 shall prescribe the kinds of information in a permit application 15

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SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to an application for a permit authorization for a municipal solid waste facility that is filed with the Texas Commission on

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- 1 Environmental Quality on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 2 An application for a permit for a municipal solid waste facility
- 3 that is filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 4 the law in effect on the date of filing, and that law is continued in
- 5 effect for that purpose.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
