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- 2 relating to alternative public school accountability
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 8, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 8.063 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 8.063. REGIONAL EDUCATION SERVICE CENTER INTERVENTION
- 8 TEAM AND PROGRAM. (a) Each regional education service center may
- 9 create an intervention team composed of seven members as follows:
- 10 (1) the executive director of the regional education
- 11 service center; and

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- 12 (2) the six superintendents employed by school
- 13 districts with the highest performance ratings in the area served
- 14 by the regional education service center.
- 15 (b) Each regional education service center intervention
- 16 team created under (a) shall develop an alternative intervention
- 17 program for districts and campuses in the area served by the
- 18 regional education service center that are subject to Chapter 39A
- 19 <u>interventions and sanctions.</u>
- 20 (c) Each regional education service center that has created
- 21 <u>an intervention team and developed an alternative intervention</u>
- 22 program shall submit a written report to the commissioner
- 23 identifying the intervention team members and the components of the
- 24 alternative intervention program.

- 1 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 39A, Education Code, is
- 2 amended by adding Section 39A.008 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 39A.008. OPTIONAL ALTERNATIVE INTERVENTION. (a)
- 4 Prior to the closure of a campus or the appointment of a board of
- 5 managers for a school district or campus under this chapter, the
- 6 commissioner may, in the alternative, place the campus or school
- 7 district under the oversight of a regional education service center
- 8 intervention team for the implementation of intervention measures
- 9 as provided under the program developed by the team under Section
- 10 8.063.
- 11 (b) If the commissioner makes an election under (a) and a
- 12 campus or school district receives an unacceptable performance
- 13 rating for two consecutive school years after such election, the
- 14 <u>commissioner shall order:</u>
- 15 (1) appointment of a board of managers to govern the
- 16 district or campus as provided by Subchapter E; or
- 17 (2) closure of the campus.
- 18 SECTION 3. Section 39A.008, Education Code, as added by
- 19 this Act, applies only to a school district that is subject to an
- 20 intervention or sanction on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 21 A school district subject to an intervention or sanction before the
- 22 effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed
- 23 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 24 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 25 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
