A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to investigating and prosecuting the criminal offense of operating an unmanned aircraft over or near certain facilities. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 423.0045, Government Code, is amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (e) to read as 6 follows: 7 A person commits an offense if the person with criminal 8 (b) negligence [intentionally or knowingly]: 9 operates an unmanned aircraft over a correctional 10 (1)11 facility, detention facility, or critical infrastructure facility 12 and the unmanned aircraft is not higher than 400 feet above ground 13 level; (2) allows an unmanned aircraft to make contact with a 14 correctional facility, detention facility, 15 or critical infrastructure facility, including any person or object on the 16 premises of or within the facility; or 17 (3) allows an unmanned aircraft to come within a 18 distance of a correctional facility, detention facility, or 19 20 critical infrastructure facility that is close enough to interfere 21 with the operations of or cause a disturbance to the facility. 22 (e) A peace officer who investigates an offense under this 23 section shall notify the Department of Public Safety of the investigation. The department may require further information from 24

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## 1 the officer as the department determines necessary.

2 SECTION 2. Section 423.0045, Government Code, as amended by 3 this Act, applies only to an offense committed on or after the 4 effective date of this Act. An offense committed before the 5 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the 6 date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in 7 effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense 8 was committed before the effective date of this Act if any element 9 of the offense occurred before that date.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
