4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 61.06693 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 61.06693. STUDY REGARDING STREAMLINING PHYSICIAN
8	LICENSING REQUIREMENTS FOR ADVANCED PRACTICE REGISTERED NURSES.
9	(a) The board shall collaborate with at least one institution of
10	higher education, the Texas Medical Board, and the Texas Board of
11	Nursing to conduct a study regarding the feasibility of developing
12	a pilot program to streamline the requirements for an advanced
13	practice registered nurse to become eligible under Chapter 155,
14	Occupations Code, for a license to practice medicine.
15	(b) Not later than December 1, 2020, the board shall submit
16	to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house
17	of representatives, and each legislative standing committee with
18	primary jurisdiction over matters relating to higher education or
19	occupational licensing a report on the results of the study and any
20	recommendations for legislative or other action.
