(a) The board shall 8 9 collaborate with at least one institution of higher education, the Texas Medical Board, and the Texas Board of Nursing to conduct a 10 study regarding the feasibility of developing a pilot program to 11 12 streamline the requirements for a nurse to become eligible under Chapter 155, Occupations Code, for a license to practice medicine. 13 14 (b) Not later than December 1, 2020, the board shall submit to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house 15

- of representatives, and each legislative standing committee with primary jurisdiction over matters relating to higher education or occupational licensing a report on the results of the study and any recommendations for legislative or other action.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
