S.B. No. 2046

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT  
2 relating to the photograph on certain forms of state issued  
3 identification.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 1702.232(c), Occupations Code, is  
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (c) The pocket card must:

8 (1) state the name of the registrant;

9 (2) contain a ~~color~~ photograph, affixed to the  
10 pocket card by the board at the time the card is issued, and the  
11 signature of the registrant;

12 (3) state the date the card was issued and the card's  
13 expiration date; and

14 (4) state each endorsement held by the registrant and  
15 the date the endorsement expires.

16 SECTION 2. Section 411.179(a), Government Code, is amended  
17 to read as follows:

18 (a) The department by rule shall adopt the form of the  
19 license. A license must include:

20 (1) a number assigned to the license holder by the  
21 department;

22 (2) a statement of the period for which the license is  
23 effective;

24 (3) a ~~color~~ photograph of the license holder;

1           (4) the license holder's full name, date of birth, hair  
2 and eye color, height, weight, and signature;

3           (5) the license holder's residence address or, as  
4 provided by Subsection (d), the street address of the courthouse in  
5 which the license holder or license holder's spouse serves as a  
6 federal judge or the license holder serves as a state judge;

7           (6) the number of a driver's license or an  
8 identification certificate issued to the license holder by the  
9 department; and

10          (7) the designation "VETERAN" if required under  
11 Subsection (e).

12          SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to  
13 a pocket card or license issued or renewed on or after the effective  
14 date of this Act. A pocket card or license issued or renewed before  
15 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when  
16 the pocket card or license was issued, and the former law is  
17 continued in effect for that purpose.

18          SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
