15	(C) a ferry or ferry landing;								
16	(D) a pedestrian or bicycle facility;								
17	(E) an intermodal hub;								
18	(F) an air quality improvement initiative;								
19	(G) a public utility facility;								
20	(H) a transit system;								
21	(I) a parking area, structure, or facility or a								
22	collection device for parking fees;								
23	(J) if applicable, projects and programs listed								
24	in the most recently approved state implementation plan for the

No. 2054 area covered by the authority, including an early action compact; 1 2 (K) improvements in а transportation 3 reinvestment zone designated under Subchapter E, Chapter 222; and 4 (L) port security, transportation, or facility 5 projects eligible for funding under Section 55.002. 6 (b) This section applies only to a road district that: 7 (1) operates or contributes to the operations of a 8 ferry system; or (2) was created for the purpose of operating or 9 contributing to the operation of a ferry system, regardless of 10 whether the district continues to operate or contribute to the 11 12 operation of a ferry system. (c) A road district may: 13 14 (1) enter into a lease, service agreement, license 15 agreement, franchise agreement, or other similar agreement with a 16 person governing: 17 (A) the person's use of a transportation project; 18 and 19 (B) the rights and obligations of the district 20 with respect to the transportation project; 21 (2) spend the road district's revenue on a 22 transportation project or public improvement project in the district for any purpose related to a transportation project or 23 public improvement project, including for the acquisition, 24 construction, maintenance, or operation of the transportation 25 26 project or public improvement project; and 27 (3) send surplus revenue to the county in which the
