Subchapter S, Chapter 61, Education Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 61.8233 to read as follows: Sec. 61.8233. WAIVER OF TUITION AND FEES FOR COURSES NOT 8 TRANSFERRED TOWARD DEGREE PROGRAM. Notwithstanding any other 9 provision, an institution of higher education that admits a student 10 transferring from another institution of higher education shall 11 12 waive the tuition and required fees that would otherwise be imposed for the student for a number of semester credit hours equal to the 13 14 number of semester credit hours earned by the student in the core curriculum or a field of study curriculum of the sending 15 16 institution for which the receiving institution: (1) does not award the student academic credit toward 17 the student's degree program; or 18 (2) awards only elective credit. 19 SECTION 2. Section 61.827, Education Code, is amended to 20 21 read as follows: 22 Sec. 61.827. RULES. The board is authorized to adopt rules 23 implementing the provisions of this subchapter, including rules to

24 ensure compliance with this subchapter.

S.B. No. 2058 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020 academic year.

3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
