A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to methane gas reduction by The University of Texas
- 3 System.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 66, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 66.455 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 66.455. METHANE REDUCTION PLANS. Under each lease
- 8 relating to oil or gas issued under this subchapter, the lessee
- 9 shall implement a methane reduction plan reviewed and approved by
- 10 the board of regents of The University of Texas System under
- 11 procedures adopted by the board. The University of Texas Bureau of
- 12 Economic Geology shall assist the board and the lessee in matters
- 13 relating to the plan.
- 14 SECTION 2. (a) In this section, "bureau" means The
- 15 University of Texas Bureau of Economic Geology.
- 16 (b) The bureau shall:
- 17 (1) conduct a study on best practices in the reduction
- 18 of methane emissions from oil and gas operations; and
- 19 (2) develop recommendations for legislation that
- 20 would result in the implementation of best practices in the
- 21 reduction of methane emissions from oil and gas operations.
- 22 (c) The study must investigate:
- 23 (1) the technical and economic potential to minimize
- 24 methane emissions from oil and gas operations on land held by The

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- 1 University of Texas System;
- 2 (2) standards in place in other states and across the
- 3 industry to minimize methane emissions from oil and gas operations;
- 4 (3) the savings achievable through the adoption of
- 5 standards identified in Subdivision (2); and
- 6 (4) policies designed to reduce methane gas emissions
- 7 on land held by The University of Texas System.
- 8 (d) Not later than December 1, 2020, the bureau shall submit
- 9 to each standing committee of the legislature having primary
- 10 jurisdiction over oil and gas development:
- 11 (1) a report of the findings of the study conducted
- 12 under this section; and
- 13 (2) recommendations for legislation that would result
- 14 in the implementation of best practices in the reduction of methane
- 15 emissions from oil and gas operations.
- 16 (e) This section expires January 1, 2021.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
