A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to affirmative defenses for a Texas Commission on Environmental Quality enforcement action for unauthorized emission 3 or opacity events. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. The following provisions of the Health and Safety Code are repealed: 7 (1) Sections 382.0216(f) and (h); and 8 (2) Sections 382.051962(c) and (d). 9 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 10 11 enforcement action initiated by the Texas Commission on an 12 Environmental Quality on or after the effective date of this Act. An enforcement action initiated before the effective date of this Act 13 14 is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that 15 16 purpose. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 19 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

21 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
