4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Sections $16.051(a-1)$ and (d) , Water Code, are
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a-1) The state water plan must include:
8	(1) an assessment of the best available science
9	related to trends in factors affecting:
\cap	(A) futuro water awailahility including

- 10 (A) future water avaılabılıty,
- precipitation, evaporation, storage capacity, and environmental 11
- 12 flow needs; and
- 13 (B) future water use, including technologies for
- 14 water conservation, purification, and reuse;
- 15 (2) an evaluation of the state's progress in meeting
- future water needs, including an evaluation of the extent to which 16
- water management strategies and projects implemented after the 17
- adoption of the preceding state water plan have affected that 18
- 19 progress;
- 20 (3) [(2)] an analysis of the number of projects
- 21 included in the preceding state water plan that received financial
- 22 assistance from the board; and
- 23 (4) (4) with respect to projects included in the
- 24 preceding state water plan that were given a high priority by the

- 1 board for purposes of providing financial assistance under
- 2 Subchapter G, Chapter 15:
- 3 (A) an assessment of the extent to which the
- 4 projects were implemented in the decade in which they were needed;
- 5 and
- 6 (B) an analysis of any impediments to the
- 7 implementation of any projects that were not implemented in the
- 8 decade in which they were needed.
- 9 (d) The board, in coordination with the commission, the
- 10 Department of Agriculture, and the Parks and Wildlife Department,
- 11 shall adopt by rule guidance principles for the state water plan
- 12 which reflect the public interest of the entire state. When
- 13 adopting guidance principles, due consideration shall be given to
- 14 the best available science related to forecasting future water
- 15 availability, the environmental flow standards and environmental
- 16 flow set-asides adopted by the commission under Section 11.1471,
- 17 the construction and improvement of surface water and groundwater
- 18 resources, and the application of principles that result in
- 19 voluntary redistribution of water resources. The board shall
- 20 review and update the guidance principles, with input from the
- 21 commission, the Department of Agriculture, and the Parks and
- 22 Wildlife Department, as necessary but at least every five years to
- 23 coincide with the five-year cycle for adoption of a new water plan
- 24 as described in Subsection (a).
- 25 SECTION 2. This Act applies to the state water plan required
- 26 to be adopted by the Texas Water Development Board beginning with
- 27 the 2017 state water plan.

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
