1-20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to a reduction in required days of service for educators in
 1-23 public schools under certain circumstances.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 21.401, Education Code, is amended by
 1-26 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c-1) to read as
 1-27 follows:

1-28 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c-1), an [An] educator
 1-29 employed under a 10-month contract must provide a minimum of 187
 1-30 days of service.

1-31 (c-1) If a school district anticipates providing less than
 1-32 180 days of instruction for students during a school year, as
 1-33 indicated by the district's academic calendar, the district may
 1-34 reduce the number of days of service required by this section
 1-35 proportionately. A reduction by the district does not reduce an
 1-36 educator's salary.

1-37 SECTION 2. Section 21.401, Education Code, as amended by
 1-38 this Act, applies only to a contract executed on or after the
 1-39 effective date of this Act. A contract executed before the
 1-40 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
 1-41 date the contract was executed, and the former law is continued in
 1-42 effect for that purpose.

1-43 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-44 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-45 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-46 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-47 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
