2	relating to inclusion of Bible instruction in the required English
3	language arts curriculum for public school students.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 28.002, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsections (x) and (y) to read as follows:
7	(x) In adopting the essential knowledge and skills for the
8	English language arts curriculum under Subsection (a)(1)(A), the
9	State Board of Education shall adopt essential knowledge and skills
10	that include instruction on the content, characters, poetry, and
11	narratives of the Bible that are prerequisites to understanding
12	United States and Texas history and contemporary society and
13	culture. In adopting essential knowledge and skills under this
14	subsection, the board:
15	(1) may not require a student to use a specific
16	translation as the sole text of the Bible and must allow the student
17	to use a different translation from that chosen by the board of
18	trustees of the student's school district or the student's teacher;

20	(2) shall ensure:
21	(A) all applicable federal and state guidelines
22	regarding maintaining religious neutrality and accommodating the
23	diverse religious views, traditions, and perspectives of students
24	in their school district are followed; and

- 1 (B) a particular religion, nonreligious faith,
- 2 or religious perspective is not endorsed, favored, promoted,
- 3 <u>disfavored</u>, or shown hostility.
- 4 (y) Nothing in Subsection (x) is intended to violate any
- 5 provision of the United States Constitution, federal law, the Texas
- 6 Constitution, or any state law.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020
- 8 school year.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
