## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the training and responsibilities of certain
- 3 educational entities that have certain responsibilities regarding

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 11.151, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (b-1) The primary responsibility of the trustees is to
- 9 facilitate the education of the district's students.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 11.159, Education Code, is amended by
- 11 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 12 (f) The State Board of Education shall ensure that any
- 13 orientation or training for a trustee related to the state laws
- 14 governing public education emphasizes the responsibilities of a
- 15 trustee under this subchapter.
- SECTION 3. Section 21.043(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 17 read as follows:
- 18 (a) The agency shall provide the board with access to data
- 19 obtained under the Public Education Information Management System
- 20 (PEIMS). The board shall use the data to revise educator
- 21 preparation program requirements recommended by the board as needed
- 22 to ensure the quality of educators certified in the state.
- SECTION 4. Section 21.046, Education Code, is amended by
- 24 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:

- 1 (f) In creating the qualifications for certification as a
- 2 superintendent or principal, the board shall consider demonstrated
- 3 knowledge of, as applicable:
- 4 (1) the responsibilities of a superintendent under
- 5 Sections 11.1512 and 11.201; or
- 6 (2) the responsibilities of a principal under Section
- 7 11.202.
- 8 SECTION 5. Section 39A.052, Education Code, is amended to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 39A.052. CAMPUS INTERVENTION TEAM MEMBERS; TRAINING.
- 11 (a) A campus intervention team assigned by the commissioner under
- 12 Section 39A.051 must [may] include teachers, principals, other
- 13 educational professionals, and superintendents that, to the
- 14 greatest extent possible, are recognized for excellence in their
- 15 roles and appointed by the commissioner to serve as members of a
- 16 team.
- 17 (b) The commissioner shall require members of the campus
- 18 intervention team to attend training on the team's responsibilities
- 19 and the interventions and sanctions that may be imposed on a
- 20 district or campus under this chapter.
- 21 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
