DUTIES OF LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY FILING CASE. 8 A law enforcement agency filing a case with the attorney 9 (a) representing the state shall submit to the attorney representing 10 the state a written statement by a peace officer employed by the 11 12 agency acknowledging that all documents, items, and information in the possession of the agency that are required to be disclosed to 13 14 the defendant in the case under Article 39.14(h) have been transmitted to the attorney representing the state. 15 16 (b) If at any time after the case is filed with the attorney representing the state the law enforcement agency discovers or 17 acquires any additional document, item, or information required to 18 be disclosed to the defendant under Article 39.14(h) or (k), a peace 19 officer employed by the agency shall promptly transmit the 20 document, item, or information to the attorney representing the 21 22 state. 23 (c) A law enforcement agency shall promptly disclose to each attorney representing the state with whom the agency files cases 24

1	the identity of each peace officer or other employee of the agency
2	for whom a finding of misconduct has been sustained if that finding
3	would be required to be disclosed to a defendant under Article
4	39.14.
5	SECTION 2. Section 1701.501(a), Occupations Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) Except as provided by Subsection (d), the commission
8	shall revoke or suspend a license, place on probation a person whose
9	license has been suspended, or reprimand a license holder for a
10	violation of:
11	<pre>(1) this chapter;</pre>
12	(2) the reporting requirements provided by Articles
13	2.132 and 2.134, Code of Criminal Procedure;
14	(3) a duty imposed by Article 2.1397, Code of Criminal
15	Procedure; or
16	(4) [ <del>(3)</del> ] a commission rule.
17	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
