S.B. No. 2125

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the regulation of aggregate production operation by the
- 3 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality; increasing an
- 4 administrative penalty.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 7.052, Water Code, is amended by adding
- 7 Subsection (b-5) to read as follows:
- 8 (b-5) The amount of the penalty against a facility operator
- 9 for operating an aggregate production operation, as defined by
- 10 Section 28A.001, in violation of a permit issued by the commission
- 11 under Section 26.027 or 26.040 of this code or under Section
- 12 382.051, Health and Safety Code, may not exceed \$50,000 a day for
- 13 <u>each day a violation continues.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 7.069, Water Code, is amended by
- 15 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 16 follows:
- 17 (a) Except as provided by <u>Subsections</u> [<u>Subsection</u>] (b) <u>and</u>
- 18 (c), a penalty collected under this subchapter shall be deposited
- 19 to the credit of the general revenue fund.
- 20 (c) A penalty collected under Section 7.052(b-5) shall be
- 21 paid to the commission and deposited to the credit of the water
- 22 resources management account and that money may be used only to
- 23 implement Chapter 28A.
- SECTION 3. Section 28A.053(a), Water Code, is amended to

- 1 read as follows:
- 2 (a) The commission shall inspect each active aggregate
- 3 production operation in this state for compliance with applicable
- 4 environmental laws and rules under the jurisdiction of the
- 5 commission at least once every $\underline{\text{two}}$ [three] years.
- 6 SECTION 4. (a) The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 7 7.052, Water Code, applies only to a violation that occurs on or
- 8 after the effective date of this Act. For purposes of this section,
- 9 a violation occurs before the effective date of this Act if any
- 10 element of the violation occurs before that date.
- 11 (b) A violation that occurs before the effective date of
- 12 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date of the
- 13 violation, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 14 purpose.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
