- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 51.338, Education Code, is amended by 7 adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 8 (h) A student who has achieved a score set by the board in a
- 9 content area subject to the standards prescribed by the board under
- 10 <u>Section 51.334(b) on a high school equivalency examination</u>
- 11 administered under Section 7.111 is exempt from the requirements of
- 12 this subchapter with respect to that content area. The
- 13 commissioner of higher education by rule shall establish the period
- 14 for which an exemption under this subsection is valid.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies
- 16 beginning with the assessment of entering undergraduate students at
- 17 public institutions of higher education for the 2020 fall semester.
- 18 The assessment of an entering undergraduate student for an academic
- 19 term before that semester is governed by the law in effect before
- 20 the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect
- 21 for that purpose.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
