## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the application for and loans from the Texas military

- value revolving loan account.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 436.054, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 7 follows:

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- 8 (b) The commission is a governmental body for purposes of
- 9 the open meetings law, Chapter 551. Except as otherwise provided by
- 10 Subsection (c), Chapter 551 applies to a meeting of the commission.
- 11 (c) The commission may allow for members' participation in a
- 12 meeting by telephone or other means of telecommunication or
- 13 electronic communication to consider an application for a loan from
- 14 the Texas military value revolving loan account. Any voting
- 15 conducted by telephone or other means of telecommunication or
- 16 <u>electronic communication shall be subject to the same quorum</u>
- 17 requirements of meetings where members are present in person.
- 18 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 436, Government Code, is
- 19 amended by adding Section 436.1533 to read as follows:
- Sec. 436.1533. USE OF LOAN PROCEEDS TO PAY OTHER DEBT
- 21 INCURRED TO FINANCE PROJECT. A defense community awarded a loan of
- 22 financial assistance from the Texas military value revolving loan
- 23 account for an eligible project under this subchapter may use a
- 24 portion of the loan proceeds to pay off other debt, including

- 1 commercial debt, the defense community incurred for purposes of
- 2 financing the project.
- 3 SECTION 3. Section 436.154(a), Government Code, is amended
- 4 to read as follows:
- 5 (a) The commission shall adopt rules, in consultation with
- 6 the Texas Public Finance Authority, that contain the criteria for
- 7 evaluating the credit of a loan applicant and the financial
- 8 feasibility of a project. The commission, in consultation with the
- 9 Texas Public Finance Authority, shall also adopt a loan application
- 10 form. The application form may include:
- 11 (1) the name of the defense community and its
- 12 principal officers;
- 13 (2) the total cost of the project;
- 14 (3) the amount of state financial assistance
- 15 requested;
- 16 (4) the plan for repaying the loan; and
- 17 (5) any other information the commission requires to
- 18 perform its duties and to protect the public interest.
- 19 SECTION 4. The Texas Military Preparedness Commission is
- 20 required to implement a provision of this Act only if the
- 21 legislature appropriates money specifically for that purpose. If
- 22 the legislature does not appropriate money specifically for that
- 23 purpose, the commission may, but is not required to, implement a
- 24 provision of this Act using other appropriations available for that
- 25 purpose.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
