## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the provision of information to certain women enrolled
- 3 in the Healthy Texas Women program.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 531.0995 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 531.0995. INFORMATION FOR CERTAIN ENROLLEES IN THE
- 8 HEALTHY TEXAS WOMEN PROGRAM. (a) In this section, "Healthy Texas
- 9 Women program" means a program operated by the commission that is
- 10 substantially similar to the demonstration project operated under
- 11 former Section 32.0248, Human Resources Code, and that is intended
- 12 to expand access to preventive health and family planning services
- 13 <u>for women in this state.</u>
- 14 (b) This section applies to a woman who is automatically
- 15 enrolled in the Healthy Texas Women program following a pregnancy
- 16 for which the woman received Medicaid, but who is no longer eligible
- 17 to participate in Medicaid.
- 18 (c) After a woman described by Subsection (b) is enrolled in
- 19 the Healthy Texas Women program, the commission shall provide to
- 20 the woman:
- 21 (1) information about the Healthy Texas Women program,
- 22 including the services provided under the program; and
- 23 (2) a list of health care providers who participate in
- 24 the Healthy Texas Women program and are located in the same

- 1 geographical area in which the woman resides.
- 2 (d) The commission shall consult with the Maternal
- 3 Mortality and Morbidity Task Force established under Chapter 34,
- 4 Health and Safety Code, to improve the process for providing the
- 5 information required by Subsection (c), including by determining:
- 6 (1) the best time for providing the information; and
- 7 (2) the manner by which the information should be
- 8 provided, including the information about health care providers
- 9 described by Subsection (c)(2).
- 10 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 11 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 12 Services Commission shall adopt any rules necessary to implement
- 13 Section 531.0995, Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 14 SECTION 3. Section 531.0995, Government Code, as added by
- 15 this Act, applies only to a woman automatically enrolled in the
- 16 Healthy Texas Women program on or after January 1, 2020.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
