- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) The Office of Court Administration of the
- 6 Texas Judicial System shall conduct a study regarding the use of
- 7 forensic psychology in suits affecting the parent-child
- 8 relationship. In conducting the study, the office shall examine:
- 9 (1) the utility and efficacy of using forensic
- 10 psychology to assist courts in rendering orders in the best
- 11 interest of the child; and
- 12 (2) the total cost of a forensic psychology evaluation
- 13 and the feasibility of regularly requiring or providing those
- 14 services in suits affecting the parent-child relationship.
- 15 (b) Not later than September 1, 2020, the Office of Court
- 16 Administration of the Texas Judicial System shall file a report
- 17 containing the results of the study and recommendations for
- 18 legislation with the governor, the lieutenant governor, and the
- 19 legislature.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act expires September 1, 2021.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
