- 10 SECTION 2. Article 2.126(a), Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 (a) The tribal council of the Alabama-Coushatta [Indian]
- 13 Tribe of Texas or the tribal council of the Kickapoo Traditional
- 14 Tribe of Texas is authorized to employ and commission peace
- 15 officers for the purpose of enforcing state law within the
- 16 boundaries of the tribe's reservation.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
