A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the reporting of certain information on maternal
3	mortality to the Department of State Health Services and the
4	confidentiality of that information.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 34.001, Health and Safety Code, is
7	amended by adding Subdivisions (11-a) and (12-a) and amending
8	Subdivisions (12) and (14) to read as follows:
9	(11-a) "Pregnancy-associated death" means the death
10	of a woman by any cause that occurs during or within one year of
11	delivery or end of pregnancy, regardless of the outcome or location
12	of the pregnancy.
13	(12) "Pregnancy-related death" means the death of a
14	woman while pregnant or within one year of delivery or end of
15	pregnancy, regardless of the <u>outcome,</u> duration <u>, or location</u> [and
16	site] of the pregnancy, from any cause related to or aggravated by
17	the pregnancy or its management, but not from accidental or
18	incidental causes.
19	(12-a) "Review committee" means the Maternal Mortality
20	and Morbidity Review Committee.
21	(14) "Task force" means the <u>review committee</u> [Maternal
22	Mortality and Morbidity Task Force].
23	SECTION 2. The heading to Section 34.002, Health and Safety
24	Code, is amended to read as follows:

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Sec. 34.002. MATERNAL MORTALITY AND MORBIDITY <u>REVIEW</u>
 <u>COMMITTEE; REFERENCE IN LAW</u> [TASK FORCE].

3 SECTION 3. Section 34.002, Health and Safety Code, is 4 amended by amending Subsections (a) and (e) and adding Subsection 5 (a-1) to read as follows:

6 (a) The Maternal Mortality and Morbidity <u>Review Committee</u>
7 [Task Force] is administered by the department.

8 <u>(a-1) Notwithstanding any other law, a reference in this</u> 9 <u>chapter or other law to the Maternal Mortality and Morbidity Task</u> 10 <u>Force means the Maternal Mortality and Morbidity Review Committee.</u>

(e) A member of the task force appointed under Subsection (b)(1) is not entitled to compensation for service on the task force <u>but</u>, <u>subject</u> to <u>Section 34.014(b)</u>, <u>may be reimbursed</u> [or reimbursement] for travel or other expenses incurred by the member while conducting the business of the task force.

SECTION 4. Section 34.009(a), Health and Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) Any information pertaining to a <u>pregnancy-associated</u>
<u>death</u>, a pregnancy-related death, or severe maternal morbidity is
confidential for purposes of this chapter.

21 SECTION 5. Section 34.014, Health and Safety Code, is 22 amended to read as follows:

23 Sec. 34.014. FUNDING. <u>(a)</u> The department may accept 24 gifts and grants from any source to fund the duties of the 25 department and the task force under this chapter.

26 (b) The department may use only gifts, grants, or federal 27 funds to reimburse travel or other expenses incurred by a member of

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S.B. No. 2150 the task force in accordance with Section 34.002(e). 1 2 SECTION 6. Section 34.008, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows: 3 4 (e) For purposes of this chapter, a licensed health care provider, including a nurse, who is involved in obtaining 5 information relevant to a case of pregnancy-associated death, 6 7 pregnancy-related death, or severe maternal morbidity under this chapter and who is required under other law to report a violation 8 9 related to the provider's profession is exempt from the requirement to report the violation for information obtained under this 10 11 chapter. SECTION 7. Section 34.017, Health and Safety Code, is 12 13 amended by adding Subsections (c), (d), and (e) to read as follows: (c) The department may allow voluntary and confidential 14 15 reporting to the department of pregnancy-associated deaths and 16 pregnancy-related deaths by health care professionals, health care facilities, and persons who complete the medical certification for 17 18 a death certificate for deaths reviewed or analyzed by the review 19 committee. 20 (d) The department shall allow voluntary and confidential reporting to the department of pregnancy-associated deaths and 21 pregnancy-related deaths by family members of or other appropriate 22 23 individuals associated with a deceased patient. The department

24 shall:

25 (1) post on the department's Internet website the contact information of the person to whom a report may be submitted 26 27 under this subsection; and

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1	(2) conduct outreach to local health organizations on
2	the availability of the review committee to review and analyze the
3	deaths.
4	(e) Information reported to the department under this
5	section is confidential in accordance with Section 34.009.

6 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
