7 <u>(a-1) Notwithstanding any other law, a reference in this</u>

10 SECTION 4. Section 34.017, Health and Safety Code, is 11 amended by adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:

12 (c) The department may allow voluntary and confidential 13 reporting to the department of pregnancy-associated deaths and 14 pregnancy-related deaths by health care professionals, health care 15 facilities, and persons who complete the medical certification for 16 a death certificate for deaths reviewed or analyzed by the review 17 committee.

18 (d) The department shall allow voluntary and confidential 19 reporting to the department of pregnancy-associated deaths and 20 pregnancy-related deaths by family members of or other appropriate 21 individuals associated with a deceased patient. The department 22 shall:

23 (1) post on the department's Internet website the 24 contact information for a report submitted under this subsection; 25 and

26 (2) conduct outreach to local health organizations on 27 the availability of the review committee to review and analyze the
