4	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 61, Labor Code, is amended
5	by adding Section 61.0515 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 61.0515. WAGE CLAIM DATA. (a) In this section, "wage
7	claim data" means information collected, received, developed, or
8	maintained in the records of the commission that relates to the
9	administration of this subchapter or Subchapters C, E, or F. The
10	term does not include:
11	(1) aggregated data that does not tend to identify an
12	individual; or
13	(2) information regarding a violation or enforcement
14	of this chapter.
15	(b) The commission shall adopt and enforce reasonable rules
16	governing the confidentiality, custody, use, preservation, and
17	disclosure of wage claim data. The rules must include safeguards to
18	protect the confidentiality of identifying information regarding
19	any individual or any past or present employer or employing unit
20	contained in the wage claim data, including any information that
21	foreseeably could be combined with other publicly available
22	information to reveal identifying information regarding the
23	individual, employer, or employing unit, as applicable.
24	(c) Wage claim data is not public information for purposes

- 1 of Chapter 552, Government Code.
- 2 (d) The commission may adopt rules governing the disclosure
- 3 <u>of:</u>
- 4 (1) aggregated data that does not tend to identify an
- 5 <u>individual; or</u>
- 6 (2) information regarding violations or enforcement
- 7 of this chapter.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
