BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 61, Labor Code, is amended by adding Section 61.0515 to read as follows:

Sec. 61.0515. WAGE CLAIM DATA. (a) In this section, "wage claim data" means information collected, received, developed, or maintained in the records of the commission that relates to the administration of this subchapter or Subchapters C, E, or F. The term does not include:

(1) aggregated data that does not tend to identify an individual; or
