- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 53, Property Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 53.125 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 53.125. SURVIVAL OF RETAINAGE LIEN AFTER CERTAIN
- 8 FORECLOSURES. (a) A person who purchases property that is sold
- 9 <u>due to the foreclosure of a lien that secures a financing agreement</u>
- 10 or loan to pay for the construction or repair of an improvement to
- 11 real property takes the property subject to an unreleased retainage
- 12 lien established under Section 53.105.
- (b) For purposes of this section, "retainage" includes
- 14 retainage under Subchapter E.
- 15 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 16 a lien related to an original contract entered into on or after the
- 17 effective date of this Act. A lien related to an original contract
- 18 entered into before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 19 the law applicable to the lien immediately before the effective
- 20 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 21 purpose.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
