- 5 SECTION 1. Section 5A(a)(4), Chapter 1507 (S.B. 456), Acts
- 6 of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999 (Article 5190.14,
- 7 Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (4) "Event" means a Super Bowl, a National Collegiate
- 9 Athletic Association Final Four tournament game, the National
- 10 Basketball Association All-Star Game, the X Games, the National
- 11 Hockey League All-Star Game, the Major League Baseball All-Star
- 12 Game, a game of the National Collegiate Athletic Association Bowl
- 13 Championship Series or its successor or a National Collegiate
- 14 Athletic Association Division I Football Bowl Subdivision
- 15 postseason playoff or championship game, the National Collegiate
- 16 Athletic Association men's or women's lacrosse championships, a
- 17 World Cup Soccer game, the World Cup soccer tournament, the Major
- 18 League Soccer All-Star Game, the Major League Soccer Cup, the
- 19 Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association National Finals Rodeo, an
- 20 Elite Rodeo Association World Championship, the United States Open
- 21 Championship, the World Games, a national collegiate championship
- 22 of an amateur sport sanctioned by the national governing body of the
- 23 sport that is recognized by the United States Olympic Committee, an
- 24 Olympic activity, including a Junior or Senior activity, training

program, or feeder program sanctioned by the United States Olympic 1 2 Committee's Community Olympic Development Program, the Amateur Athletic Union Junior Olympic Games, a 3 mixed martial 4 championship, the Breeders' Cup World Championships, a Formula One automobile race, the Moto Grand Prix of the United States, the 5 National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR) All-Star 6 7 Race, the season-ending Championship Race for the National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR), the Academy of 8 9 Country Music Awards, the National Cutting Horse Association Triple Crown, a national political convention of the Republican National 10 11 Committee or the Democratic National Committee, a presidential general election debate, or the largest event held each year at a 12 13 sports entertainment venue in this state with a permanent seating capacity, including grandstand and premium seating, of not less 14 15 than 125,000 as of September 1, 2019. The term includes any 16 activities related to or associated with an event.

SECTION 2. Section 5A(a-2), Chapter 1507 (S.B. 456), Acts of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999 (Article 5190.14, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows:

20 (a-2) Subsection (a-1)(1) of this section does not apply to 21 an event that is the largest event held each year at a sports 22 entertainment venue in this state with a permanent seating capacity, including grandstand and premium seating, of not less 23 24 than 125,000 as of September 1, 2019. If an endorsing municipality 25 or endorsing county requests the department to make a determination under Subsection (b) of this section for an event described by this 26 27 subsection, the provisions of this section apply to that event as if

- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
