BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 5A(a)(4) and (5), Chapter 1507 (S.B. 6 456), Acts of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999 (Article 7 5190.14, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), are amended to read as 8 follows:

"Event" means a Super Bowl, a National Collegiate 9 (4) Athletic Association Final Four tournament game, the National 10 11 Basketball Association All-Star Game, the X Games, the National 12 Hockey League All-Star Game, the Major League Baseball All-Star Game, a game of the National Collegiate Athletic Association Bowl 13 14 Championship Series or its successor or a National Collegiate Athletic Association Division I Football Bowl Subdivision 15 16 postseason playoff or championship game, the National Collegiate Athletic Association men's or women's lacrosse championships, a 17 World Cup Soccer game, the World Cup soccer tournament, the Major 18 League Soccer All-Star Game, the Major League Soccer Cup, the 19 20 Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association National Finals Rodeo, an 21 Elite Rodeo Association World Championship, the United States Open Championship, the World Games, a national collegiate championship 22 23 of an amateur sport sanctioned by the national governing body of the sport that is recognized by the United States Olympic Committee, an 24

Olympic activity, including a Junior or Senior activity, training 1 program, or feeder program sanctioned by the United States Olympic 2 3 Committee's Community Olympic Development Program, the Amateur Athletic Union Junior Olympic Games, a mixed martial arts 4 5 championship, the Breeders' Cup World Championships, a Formula One automobile race, the Moto Grand Prix of the United States, the 6 National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR) All-Star 7 Race, the season-ending Championship Race for the 8 National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR), the AAA Texas 9 10 National Hot Rod Association (NHRA) Fall Nationals, the Academy of Country Music Awards, the National Cutting Horse Association Triple 11 12 Crown, a national political convention of the Republican National Committee or the Democratic National Committee, a presidential 13 14 general election debate, or the largest event held each year at a 15 sports entertainment venue in this state with a permanent seating capacity, including grandstand and premium seating, of not less 16 17 than 125,000 as of September 1, 2019. The term includes any activities related to or associated with an event. 18

SECTION 2. Section 5A(a-2), Chapter 1507 (S.B. 456), Acts of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999 (Article 5190.14, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows:

(a-2) Subsection (a-1)(1) of this section does not apply to 16 17 an event that is the largest event held each year at a sports entertainment venue in this state with a permanent seating 18 19 capacity, including grandstand and premium seating, of not less than 125,000 as of September 1, 2019. If an endorsing municipality 20 or endorsing county requests the department to make a determination 21 under Subsection (b) of this section for an event described by this 22 23 subsection, the provisions of this section apply to that event as if 24 it satisfied the eligibility requirements for an event under Subsection (a-1)(1) of this section. 25

26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
