- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 203.018, Human Resources Code, is
- 5 amended as follows:
- 6 (a) The department shall develop specialized programs for
- 7 children with a determinate sentence and children committed under
- 8 Section 54.04013, Family Code. The programs must ensure safety and
- 9 security for committed children and provide developmentally
- 10 appropriate program strategies.
- 11 (b) The department shall establish performance-based goals
- 12 related to improved outcomes that:
- 13 (1) must include measures to reduce recidivism; and
- 14 (2) shall include other well-being outcome measures.
- 15 (c) The department shall use case review strategies to
- 16 identify children in department facilities who can safely and
- 17 appropriately be transferred to alternative local placements or
- 18 halfway houses, placed on parole, or discharged from the
- 19 department.
- 20 (d) The department shall study and report to the board on
- 21 the potential for repurposing existing secure facilities for the
- 22 confinement of children with a determinate sentence or children
- 23 committed under Section 54.04013, Family Code, or for other
- 24 purposes.

- 1 (e) The department or any local probation department may not
- 2 use or contract with a facility that was constructed or previously
- 3 used for the confinement of adult offenders.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
