(a) In this section: 8 (1) "Health facility" means a facility licensed under 9 Subtitle B, Title 4. 10 (2) "Historic structure" has the meaning assigned by 11 12 Section 442.001, Government Code. 13 (b) This section does not apply to: 14 (1) a restroom renovation with an estimated cost of less than \$10,000; 15 (2) the construction or renovation of a building for 16 which the governmental entity issuing the building permit 17 determines that installing a diaper changing station would: 18 19 (A) be infeasible; 20 (B) result in noncompliance with federal, state, 21 or local health, life safety, or building code requirements; or (C) limit the accessibility of a restroom to a 22 23 person with a disability; 24 (3) an industrial building, nightclub, bar,
