- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 39, Utilities Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 39.159 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 39.159. ELIMINATING EFFECTS OF RENEWABLE ENERGY
- 8 SUBSIDIES. (a) The commission shall require the ERCOT independent
- 9 system operator to identify and study the ongoing effects that
- 10 federal renewable energy subsidies have on the pricing,
- 11 reliability, and efficiency of the electric power market in the
- 12 ERCOT power region. The commission shall request comments on the
- 13 study from interested parties.

- 14 (b) The scope of the study under this section must include
- 15 peak price formation, negative pricing, ancillary services,
- 16 congestion, reserve margins, and transmission costs.
- 17 (c) The commission shall include in a report required by
- 18 Section 31.003 the results of the study and a description of any
- 19 proposed rules to address the findings of the study.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
