- 12 (b) The registered voters of an authority, by petition, may
- 13 require an election to decrease the authority's sales and use tax

- 15 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 451.409, Transportation
- 16 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 451.409. SALES AND USE TAX RATE INCREASE OR DECREASE:
- 18 PETITION AND ELECTION.
- 19 SECTION 3. Sections 451.409(a), (b), and (d),
- 20 Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 21 (a) A petition to increase or decrease the rate of an
- 22 authority's sales and use tax is valid only if it is submitted to
- 23 the board and signed by at least 10 percent of the authority's
- 24 registered voters as determined by the most recent official list of

- 1 registered voters.
- 2 (b) The board shall submit a petition for an election to
- 3 increase or decrease the authority's sales and use tax rate to the
- 4 secretary of state.
- 5 (d) The board shall call an election to increase or decrease
- 6 the tax rate if the secretary determines that a petition is valid or
- 7 if the secretary fails to act within the period required by
- 8 Subsection (c).
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
