## AN ACT

2 relating to the eligibility of persons convicted of certain 3 offenses to serve as a member of a board of trustees of a school 4 district.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 11.066, Education Code, is amended to 7 read as follows:

8 Sec. 11.066. ELIGIBILITY FOR SERVICE BY TRUSTEE <u>WHO IS</u> 9 CONVICTED OF CERTAIN <u>OFFENSES</u> OR <u>WHO PLEADS</u> <u>GUILTY OR NOLO</u> 10 <u>CONTENDERE TO THOSE OFFENSES</u> [<del>OFFENSE</del>]. A person is ineligible to 11 serve as a member of the board of trustees of a school district if 12 the person has been convicted of <u>or pleaded guilty or nolo</u> 13 <u>contendere to a felony or</u> an offense under Section 43.02(b), Penal 14 Code.

15 SECTION 2. Section 11.066, Education Code, as amended by 16 this Act, applies only to a member of a board of trustees of a school 17 district who is elected or appointed on or after the effective date 18 of this Act. A member of a board of trustees of a school district 19 elected or appointed before the effective date of this Act 20 continues to serve for the term to which the member was elected or 21 appointed unless otherwise removed as provided by law.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
