AN ACT 2 relating to the eligibility of persons convicted of certain 3 offenses to serve as a member of a board of trustees of a school

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 11.066, Education Code, is amended to 7 read as follows:

8 Sec. 11.066. ELIGIBILITY FOR SERVICE BY TRUSTEE CONVICTED 9 OF CERTAIN <u>OFFENSES</u> [OFFENSE]. A person is ineligible to serve as a 10 member of the board of trustees of a school district if the person 11 has been convicted of <u>a felony or</u> an offense under Section 43.02(b), 12 Penal Code.

13 SECTION 2. Section 11.066, Education Code, as amended by 14 this Act, applies only to a member of a board of trustees of a school 15 district who is elected or appointed on or after the effective date 16 of this Act. A member of a board of trustees of a school district 17 elected or appointed before the effective date of this Act 18 continues to serve for the term to which the member was elected or 19 appointed unless otherwise removed as provided by law.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
