- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 11.066, Education Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 11.066. ELIGIBILITY FOR SERVICE BY TRUSTEE CONVICTED
- 9 OF CERTAIN OFFENSES [OFFENSE]. A person is ineligible to serve as a
- 10 member of the board of trustees of a school district if the person
- 11 has been convicted of a felony, a Class A misdemeanor, or an offense
- 12 under Section 43.02(b), Penal Code.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 11.066, Education Code, as added by this
- 14 Act, applies only to a member of a board of trustees of a school
- 15 district who is elected or appointed on or after the effective date
- 16 of this Act. A member of a board of trustees of a school district
- 17 elected or appointed before the effective date of this Act
- 18 continues to serve for the term to which the member was elected or
- 19 appointed unless otherwise removed as provided by law.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
