1-20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to the eligibility of persons convicted of certain
 1-23 offenses to serve as a member of a board of trustees of a school
 1-24 district.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Section 11.066, Education Code, is amended to
 1-27 read as follows:

1-28 Sec. 11.066. ELIGIBILITY FOR SERVICE BY TRUSTEE WHO IS
 1-29 CONVICTED OF CERTAIN OFFENSES OR WHO PLEADS GUILTY OR NOLO
 1-30 CONTENDERE TO THOSE OFFENSES [OFFENSE]. A person is ineligible to
 1-31 serve as a member of the board of trustees of a school district if
 1-32 the person has been convicted of or pleaded guilty or nolo
 1-33 contendere to a felony or an offense under Section 43.02(b), Penal
 1-34 Code.

1-35 SECTION 2. Section 11.066, Education Code, as amended by
 1-36 this Act, applies only to a member of a board of trustees of a school
 1-37 district who is elected or appointed on or after the effective date
 1-38 of this Act. A member of a board of trustees of a school district
 1-39 elected or appointed before the effective date of this Act
 1-40 continues to serve for the term to which the member was elected or
 1-41 appointed unless otherwise removed as provided by law.

1-42 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
