## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the random drug testing of members of the legislature
- 3 during a legislative session.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 571, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 571.080 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 571.080. RANDOM DRUG TESTING OF LEGISLATORS. (a) In
- 8 this section, "controlled substance" and "marihuana" have the
- 9 meanings assigned by Chapter 481, Health and Safety Code.
- 10 (b) The commission by rule shall establish a program to
- 11 randomly test members of the legislature for the use of controlled
- 12 <u>substances and marihuana during a legislative session. The program</u>
- 13 must provide for the random, unannounced drug testing of each
- 14 member at times determined by the commission during a legislative
- 15 <u>session.</u> The commission shall post on the commission's Internet
- 16 website the results of each drug test or, if applicable, a statement
- 17 that the member refused to comply with the commission's request for
- 18 drug testing.
- 19 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2020, the Texas Ethics
- 20 Commission shall adopt rules as necessary to implement Section
- 21 571.080, Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
