1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the authority of a county to require a person to obtain
1-18 a building permit from the county for certain portable structures.
1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-20 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 233, Local Government
1-21 Code, is amended by adding Section 233.902 to read as follows:
1-22 Sec. 233.902. PORTABLE STRUCTURE FOR SALE OF SEASONAL
1-23 GOODS. Notwithstanding any other law, a county may not require a
1-24 building permit to construct, improve, or occupy a structure used
1-25 for the retail sale of seasonal goods if the structure is:
1-26 (1) portable; and
1-27 (2) smaller than 500 square feet.
1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-29 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-30 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-31 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-32 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
