11	agreement with each school district located wholly or partly in a

14	<pre>million] to offer one or more courses as provided by this section.</pre>
15	A student enrolled in a school district to which this subsection
16	applies may enroll in a course at any junior college that has
17	entered into an agreement with the district to offer the course
18	under this subsection.
19	(g-2) Subsection $(g-1)$ applies only to a public junior
20	<pre>college in:</pre>
21	(1) the Blinn College District;
22	(2) the Houston Community College System District;
23	(3) the Lee College District;
24	(4) the Lone Star College System District; or

- 1 (5) the San Jacinto College District.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019 fall
- 3 semester.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
